

Pastor Carol's Corner

Isaiah 55:6a, 8-10, 12

Seek the Lord... For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts. For you shall go out in joy, and be led back in peace; the mountains and the hills before you shall burst into song, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands

The change of seasons is a poignant time. It is hard to say goodbye to the warm days of summer. But there is beauty in each season – and this autumn in particular the colored leaves have been exceptionally beautiful. In October it felt as if God were presenting an art show of colors. The brilliant leaves were glowing.

I was curious about why leaves actually change color so read several articles about the science behind it. The cool weather is only part of the reason we have autumn leaves. Through photosynthesis trees receive what they need to grow. The trees use sunlight to produce chlorophyll, giving the leaves their green color.

Most trees have completed their growth cycle by late June. As the days grow shorter, there is less sunlight to produce chlorophyll. Eventually the trees stop producing chlorophyll. In the absence of chlorophyll other colors begin to appear - the red, orange, yellow, and brown we associate with autumn. Temperature, sunlight, and soil moisture all influence the quality of autumn colors from one year to the next. [www.usna.usda.gov/]

Leaves are composed of a high percentage of water and unable to endure the winter cold. A tree seals off the area at a leaf stem to protect the tree from frost, causing leaves to fall from the tree. Evergreens keep their needles because the needles are covered with a heavy wax coating and the fluids inside the cells contain substances resistant to frost. [http://dnr.wi.gov/eek/veg/trees/

It is all an incredibly intricate process, this cycle of the seasons and the colors of autumn we enjoy. What an amazing God we worship and serve. God created this earth with its miraculously complex system. We are held and loved by God who created the trees, the birds, the flowers – and cares for each of us. Why do we ever worry? We are held in love and grace by an everlasting and eternal God.
