



Minnnesota FoodShare, a major program of the Greater Minneapolis Council of Churches (GMCC), began its work in 1982, with a campaign to restock food shelves in the 7-county Twin Cities Metropolitan Area. The effort was so successful, and the need was so great, that it became a statewide program just one year later. People across the state join forces with Minnesota FoodShare in an effort to stock food shelves during the March Campaign. There are many matching grants offered during the month, so our gifts are doubled! In 2016, the March 21 Campaign raised \$8.2 million dollars and 5.2 million pounds of food, for the most successful campaign in March 25 their 34 year history!

Calvin Church donates food to three food shelves: IOCP (Interfaith Outreach), Maple Plain Food Shelf, and

WeCan. You may bring in non-perishable food items, toiletries, or personal care items; the "most needed items" lists are posted in the Gathering Hall by the donation basket. Or you can donate through church and your money will be apportioned between the three food shelves. Please write "Foodshare" on the memo line. Help us make a difference during the month of March!
