Palm Sunday, April 9 - Worship service begins at 10:00am with special music, and the dedication of our One Great Hour of Sharing offering. Egg bake brunch will immediately follow the worship service. Sign up in the Gathering Hall.

Maundy Thursday, April 13 - Maundy Thursday takes its name from the word for *commandment*. In our worship service we will hear Scripture passages about Jesus' final evening meal he shared with his twelve disciples and share together in the sacrament of communion. We will gather in the sanctuary for worship at 7:00pm.

Good Friday, April 14 - On Good Friday we are hosting a worship service that will include the Chancel choir, a drama and Tenebrae Service. Tenebrae is the word for shadows; we hear Scripture telling of Jesus' betrayal and arrest, trial and sentencing, and the crucifixion, with the gradual extinguishing of lights in the sanctuary. First Presbyterian Church of Maple Plain will be joining us and worship begins at 6:30pm.

Easter Sunday, April 16 - Easter morning worship service at 10:00am. There will be no Adult Education or Sunday School classes. Coffee Fellowship immediately follow worship.

More than 300 million palm fronds are harvested each year for U.S. consumption alone — most of them for Palm Sunday, but also for floral displays for church-related events. Calvin's commitment to purchase eco-palms plays an important role in protecting forests, local jobs, and sustainable livelihoods in the harvesting communities. For more information, visit

Throughout this Lenten season both Sunday worship and Wednesday evening services have focused on the Gospel of John. From the opening sentence, John's Gospel declares that we are going to hear testimony about the Son of God, the Christ, Savior, who was one with God from the beginning of time. In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. John 1:1-2, 5

Throughout John's Gospel there is no doubt that Jesus is showing the face of God: Jesus said, I am the bread of life. (John 6:35) I am the light of the world. (John 8:12) I am the gate. (John 10:9) I am the good shepherd. (John 10:14) I am the resurrection and the life. (John 11:25) I am the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6) I am the vine, you are the branches. (John 15:5)
