

CALVIN TO HOST NEW SPARKS PROGRAM

The Session at its April meeting met with Melanie DeLuca, Director of Community Education at Orono Schools. A request had come for our church to consider being a host site for a new youth mentoring and academic support program called SPARKS.

The complete letter about SPARKS is on the bulletin board. Below are excerpts.

What is SPARKS?

SPARKS is a new program for elementary and Middle School age students that is neighborhood based, provided by the Orono School District, and coordinated by Community Education. The goal is to provide community based intervention that offers extra time and support to children with academic and financial need.

How are children chosen to participate?

Children invited to participate come from low-income families and they are identified by school staff as needing extra academic support. There is no cost for participants.

What will SPARKS be doing at Calvin?

A licensed teacher and site coordinator along with volunteers will provide homework help, academic support, reading time, relationship building, and encouragement to students.

How often will SPARKS be meeting at Calvin?

The program time is 3-5 pm two days per week on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

How will the program operate?

The program is managed by the Community Education Department. The SPARKS staff will be employees of the district. Calvin is encouraged to promote employment and volunteer opportunities within the church.

What is the church responsible for with regards to SPARKS?

Calvin will provide space with tables and chairs and a spot for a movable locked storage cabinet for storage of materials. Any church members can volunteer and receive training to be a part of the program.

How soon with SPARKS begin to meet at Calvin?

The plan is to start on October 10th, 2016 and meet twice weekly through May.

Melanie DeLuca will give a Moment for Mission in worship on **May 15**th to explain more about the program, answer questions, and recruit volunteers.

Pastor Carol's Corner

"When the Feast of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Without warning there was a sound like a strong wind, gale force—no one could tell where it came from. It filled the whole building. Then, like a wildfire, the Holy Spirit spread through their ranks, and they started speaking in a number of different languages as the Spirit prompted them."

Act 2:1-5, The Message translation

May 15th is the day of Pentecost. Pentecost is sometimes called the birth-day of the church, for it is the day the Spirit filled the believers of Jesus Christ, giving them a focus and direction for what they would do going

forward. The believers in that time following the resurrection were called followers of *The Way*. It was some time before they came to be called the *Church*.

This past year during my Sabbatical I attended worship services in the York Minister in England (where Pentecost is called Whitsunday), with a Church of England congregation in a coastal village in Cornwall, England whose roots go back to the I500s, to the Iona Abbey, the church on the island where I studied and where Christianity first arrived in Scotland in 563AD, to a small Presbyterian church gathering in the center of the city of Glasgow, Scotland, to the chapel at Ghost Ranch, the Presbyterian retreat center in Abiquiu New Mexico. As we approach this Pentecost season, we are reminded that wherever two or three are gathered, Christ is in our midst. (Matthew 18:20) Our differences fall away when we are united in Christ's name.


