of all genres and musicians of all ilks.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Weekly rehearsals (Wednesdays, 7-8:30p),

Weekly services (Sunday, 9:30a call / 10a Worship

Musical preparation as section leader, ability to sing independently, solo

opportunities are available, but not mandatory.

Monthly opportunities to conduct: rehearsals, services, handbell choir.

Church Holidays are strongly encouraged, but scheduling is flexible to

accommodate scholar's travel and family obligations (especially Christmas).

**COMPENSATION:** A monthly stipend of \$240 is allocated to Choral Scholars. This payment is

untaxed, and considered a scholarship for degree-seeking students.
