Pastor Carol's Coma

"As good stewards of the varied gifts given you by God, let each use the gift received in service of others." I Peter 4:10

Every November Calvin Church, like most churches across the US, finds itself in stewardship season. Generally that means we talk about the church budget and what we need to cover things like the utilities, snow removal, paying staff salaries. But stewardship is at its core much more.

If we look at the Bible's definition, a steward is someone who cares for the world and all the creatures God created. Psalm 24 says: "The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it, the world and those who live in it." Stewardship begins with the affirmation that we live in a God-given world, that we belong to God – all that we have and all that we own comes from God.

Being a steward and practicing stewardship becomes more than deciding what dollar amount to give to the church. Stewardship imitates God's example of giving. Stewardship becomes a spiritual practice – a part of living as a disciple of Jesus Christ.

If we think of stewardship as only giving money to pay bills at the church, it becomes an obligation. Being a steward in the church means participating in the life of the body of Christ. It includes all the other things people do to support the mission and ministry of the church – whether it is singing in the choir, ushering on Sunday morning, participating in the prayer chain, serving as an Elder or a Deacon, helping with the community meals, or donating to the various special offerings throughout the year.

It takes a community of people sharing their gifts and their resources to make a church like Calvin a vibrant, faithful community. Thanks for all you do to support the body of Christ at this place!
