Stewardship Update – We are a people of faith, and our budget is based on faith as well. As of October's end, we are about \$20,000 short of where our faith budget indicates we should be to stay out of "The Red." Being such a small congregation, every pledge and dollar matters! Please keep the needs of our church community at heart as you consider your offerings for the end of the year. ~Skelly Shaughnessy, Chair of Finance & Stewardship

Pledge cards are still being received. They may be placed in the offering plate on Sunday, mailed to church, or given to the financial secretary.

The Presbyterian Church is a connectional church, meaning we aren't an independent entity but part of a denomination. To support the ministry of the Presbytery of the Twin Cities Area, Synod of Lakes & Prairies, and General Assembly (the entire denomination), we are required to pay a yearly fee for each confirmed member.

The Per Capita amount per confirmed member for 2019 is \$35.70. Each payment of Per Capita is a help to the Calvin Church budget.


