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Pastor Carol's Corner

For many Christians, Lent is a time for giving something up, perhaps caffeine or sugar or meat on Fridays. Presbyterians often take a different approach, encouraging *adding* a spiritual practice – prayer or reading of Scripture for instance, something that draws us closer to God.

Recently I came across an article on a United Methodist Church website about giving things up in Lent that gave me pause. Here are some of the suggestions from the author, Rev. Magrey deVega.

- 1. Give up comparing yourself to others. We need not be defined by what others have and what you do not have. Find contentment with what we have, and who God created us to be.
- 2. Give up your fear of the future. We surely all have fears about the unknown, but do not let your life be defined by them. We worship a God of hope. Jesus said: Do not worry about tomorrow for tomorrow will bring worries of its own. Matthew 6:34
- 3. Give up the avoidance of difficulties. No one likes difficulties or sadness. But numbing ourselves to them can lead to self-destructive patterns like addiction. That is when life gets really scary.
- 4. Give up the need to be in control. The Presbyterian Brief Statement of Faith begins: In life and death we belong to God. It reminds us that we do not control the future, but hold to the belief that God is in charge.
- 5. Give up the need to make everyone happy. How much wiser to take the advice from Galatians 1:10 Am I now seeking human approval, or God's approval? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still pleasing people, I would not be a servant of Christ.
- 6. Give up the non-essential noise in life. We are inundated by so much that is vying for our attention and devotion. Turn off the phone for a day. Watch less television; read more books. Take a walk; watch the sunset. Give thanks to God who is ready to do a new thing in you this Lent.




