Pastor John's message...

Happy Easter!

As I write this, we're just about finishing up our Lenten mid week services. We have been meeting with our close neighbors, First Presbyterian of Maple Plain, and learned about a few spiritual practices. Prayer, bible study, worship, service...there are more that we didn't get a chance to talk about – but they all lead to a life of resurrection.

Technically, I think the definition of resurrection has to do with becoming alive again after being dead, but I think it is an idea that we can learn from and grow into as individuals, as families, and as a congregation. Resurrection means leading a life of... well, LIFE!

Without suggesting anything to you about his personal theology, I really think Thoreau hit the nail on the head when he said "Most [people] lead lives of quiet desperation." We exist mostly, we don't LIVE. And that in itself may mean many things to different people, but my point is that Jesus came so that we might have abundant life, not merely existing (John 10). Sin entered into the world and caused humanity to die spiritually (Genesis 3), and Christ lived and died and was raised so that we could LIVE. Really live.

All of us, no matter how old we are, no matter how little we might know of the world, we are equipped and called and sent to lead lives of hope and grace, not desperation. The problem is that most of us don't. So this Easter – throughout the entire Easter season – my hope and prayer is that you will find ways of living that grow a renewed sense of hope and love in all that you do. Easter is a time of new life, of renewal, of second (and third, and fourth, and....) chances! Don't let it pass you by!
