2024 Men's Retreat February 16 @ 6 pm to February 18 @ noon



Join us at the beautiful Eagle Lodge at Clearwater Forest Camp and Retreat Center (two hours north of Maple Plain). Over Friday evening through Sunday morning, we will spend a rejuvenating time of reflection, rest, fellowship, service, and play.

Reflection — Pastor TJ Shirley will lead our study/reflection time based on the movie Secondhand Lions. This movie is a 2003 American comedy-drama film written and directed by Tim McCanlies. It tells the story of an introverted young boy (Haley Joel Osment) who is sent to live with his eccentric great uncles (Robert Duvall and Michael Caine) on a farm in Texas.

Rest — It will be a low-stress environment, getting "unplugged" and "away from it all". You will have time for that leisurely walk, or taking that afternoon nap that you never have time for. There'll be time to just...relax.

Fellowship — We will cook, eat, and clean up together. We will study, sing, pray, and worship together. We will play and work together. And just maybe, we will develop friendships that we didn't expect.

Service — We will help out the camp by providing "manpower" to do something that the camp needs to have done (pun intended). This is often refilling each building's stock of firewood; but we have also done other things for them.

Play — There are lots of possible opportunities, both outside and inside. Outside: snowshoeing, skiing, ice fishing, hiking. Inside: reading, cards and games, ping pong, cooking, and music.

Registration Fee — \$175. This includes food, lodging and other expenses for the whole weekend. Some snacks and beverages will be provided as part of the fee. Scholarships are available for people associated with FPC of Maple Plain. We can work with other churches to provide scholarships for their participants as well.
