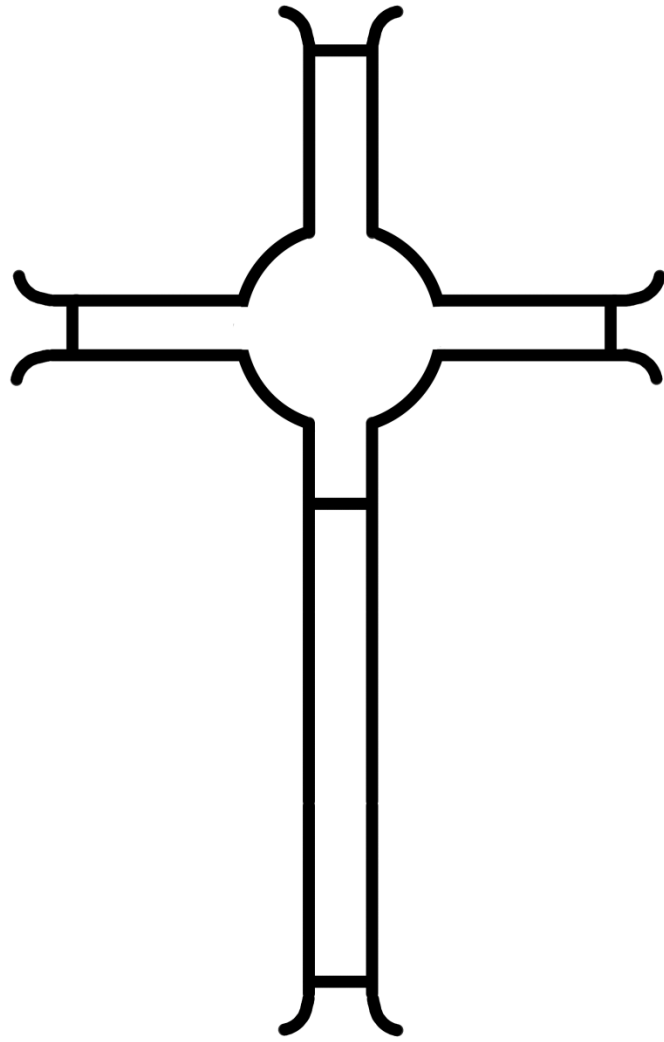

The Spirit unites all believers to Christ, dwells in them as their Comforter and Sanctifier, gives to them the spirit of Adoption and Prayer, and performs all those gracious offices by which believers are sanctified and sealed unto the day of redemption.
