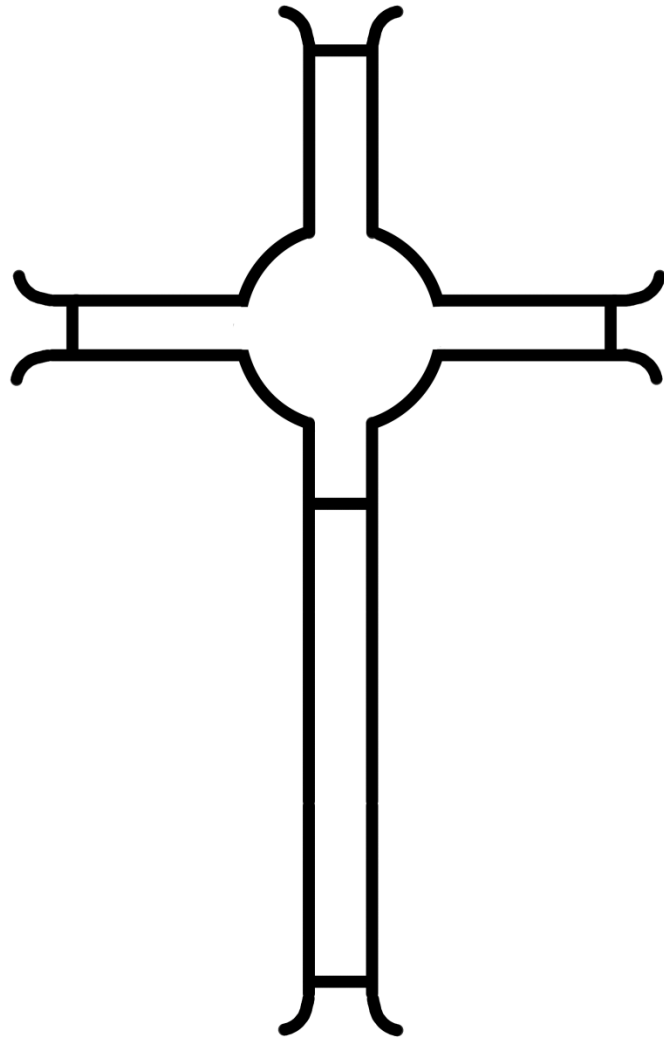

From the Scots Confession
