* AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

from The Second Helvetic Confession

Those who are in the Church have one faith and one spirit; and therefore they worship but one God, and God alone they worship in spirit and in truth, loving God alone with all their hearts and with all their strength, praying unto God alone through Jesus Christ, the only Mediator and Intercessor; and they do not seek righteousness and life outside Christ and faith in him. Because they acknowledge Christ the only head and foundation of the Church, and, resting on him, daily renew themselves by repentance, and patiently bear the cross laid upon them. Moreover, joined together with all the members of Christ by an unfeigned love, they show that they are Christ's disciples by persevering in the bond of peace and holy unity. At the same time they participate in the sacraments instituted by Christ, and delivered unto us by his apostles, using them in no other way than as they received them from the Lord.
