A huge thank you to everyone who contributed pies for our Pie Sunday. We had 10 different kinds of pie, all of which were delicious.

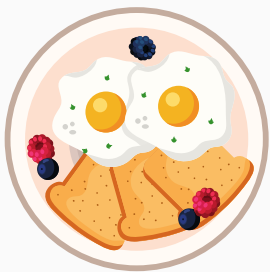
ADULT EDUCATION CLASS

LED BY REV. DWIGHT R. CHAMBERLAIN

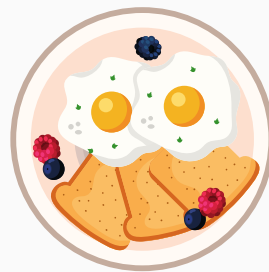
The Adult Education Class will meet each Sunday in March, at 9:15a.m. in the Fellowship Hall.
