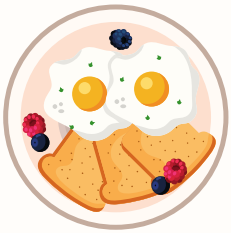


# Adult Education Class

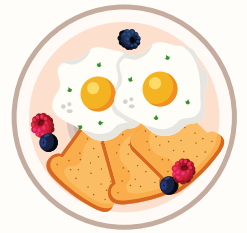

Our Calvin Presbyterian Women's group is supporting an effort of PW at the Synod level to provide baby layettes for the new young mothers on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation. These layettes are presented during a Welcome the Child ceremony 3 or 4 times a year.

Each layette includes: 2 sleepers, 2 onesies, 1 outfit (winter or summer), 1 hat, 2 pairs of socks, 2 bibs, 1 hooded towel, 1 wash cloth, 2 receiving blankets, 1 baby blanket. I'm counting on Calvin people to knit the hats, Martha has contributed some quilts, and I need to get busy making blankets. Each layette costs about \$50.
